You will enter this home from the rear! Pages 3,4, and 5 have a map and photosuse those in conjunction with reading pages 1 and 2 and everything should be a piece of cake!

DIRECTIONS PART 1: Getting to S. Paca St.

OPTION A - If coming into town on I-295 from Washington DC / BWI (airport)

Take 295 straight into town and it will turn into Russell Street. You will pass Raven's Stadium on the right, and then you'll approach and begin to pass Camden Yards. As you are rounding Camden Yards, make a sharp left onto Washington Blvd. (This left is almost like a U-turn. Pickles Pub is noted on the map at this turn. This road is closed at this intersection during some baseball games and special events. If you cannot make the left, see Note 1 below). At the next light make a left in front of the Sunoco Station onto Greene St./Russell St. (street changes names at this intersection). Take the second right after the Sunoco onto S. Paca St (if you get to another light you've missed S. Paca St, see Note 2 below) -- and now proceed to PART 2 below...

NOTE 1: If you cannot make the left onto Washington Blvd because it's closed or you miss the turn, proceed ahead two more lights and take a left onto Lombard Street. Go one block and take the next left onto Greene Street. After two blocks you will see the Sunoco on the right, go past the Sunoco and take the second right onto S. Paca St.

NOTE 2: In the event you miss the turn onto S. Paca take next right you can make and pull into the ABC Party Rentals lot to regroup. If you don't pull over immediately at the ABC party Rentals or shortly thereafter, you can very easily end up back on the interstate or 295 heading out of town. You would then go back to the light at that intersection, take a left onto Russell street and follow the directions above again.

OPTION B - If coming into town on I-95 from north or south

Take Exit 53 (395 and MLK). Follow signs to MLK. At 2nd light, make a right onto Pratt St. At 2nd light, make right onto Greene St. Go through the next set of lights, go past the Sunoco, and take the second right after the Sunoco onto S. Paca St (1st street after Sunoco is a small one-way alley coming out). In the event you miss S. Paca St and/or you get to another stop light (which means you missed S. Paca St), see NOTE 2 above. Otherwise, proceed to PART 2 below...

DIRECTIONS PART 2 - Once on S. Paca St. (and getting to the REAR of the home)

Once you make the right hand turn onto S. Paca St., the house is ~200 yards down on the left, BUT you're going to park in the **rear of the house** and enter and exit most of the time through the **rear of the house**. As such, once on S. Paca St, take the first left onto Warner St, then take the first right onto the one-way alley (**Burgundy St**). (See pics on page 4) You are going to park just past a garage on the right hand side of the alley about half way down the alley (there is an address plaque on the garage stating 625 S. Paca St, and the parking pad for 627 is just past that.

There is a plaque on the set back wrought iron fence identifying 627 S. Paca St. (see photo on page 4 for further identification)

Parking Pad

There is a large telephone pole which makes pulling into the parking space while moving forward challenging but doable with a small car. However, with a midsize car or larger, you will find it much easier to go past the spot and then back into it. It helps if you stay to the center or right side of the alley as you go past -- it's so much easier this way!!!

House access:

Walk thru the wrought iron gate (it's never locked, but there is a gravity latch that holds it shut). Go up onto the deck and there is a lockbox immediately to the right of the back door.

Specific Lockbox Instructions

- 1) Push down on the 'clear' button to clear out any numbers that may have been accidentally pushed since the last time the lockbox was opened.
- 2) Push 6-2-7-0 and then push down and gently pull out on the 'open' button. NOTE: If you make a mistake entering the numbers, push down on the 'clear' button and try again.
- 3) To close the lockbox With the cover in your hand, push 6-2-7-0, then position the cover in the box and pull down on the 'open' button and close the box.

Keys for entry and exit during your stay

There are three keys on the kitchen counter to be used during your stay. More on those in the Check In Document

Backup Lockbox


There is a gate to the left of the back door. It is just held shut by a gravity latch. Go thru that gate and down into the stairwell at the end of the corridor, and there is a lock box in the doorway itself, about eye high. The combo for this box is also '6270'. The key inside will open the door you are standing in front of. This side door should only be used in case of emergency, and the key must be put back in the lockbox immediately.
